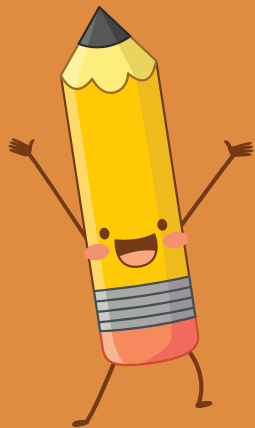

# FSA / SAT



- Grade's Kindergarten – 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade will be taking the Stanford Achievement Test (SAT)
- Grade's 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> will be administered the FSA ELA(Reading) and FSA Math assessment.
- Grade's 4<sup>th</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> will be administered the FSA Writing Assessment
- Grade 5 will be administered the FSA Science Assessment

# Testing Requirements For 2021

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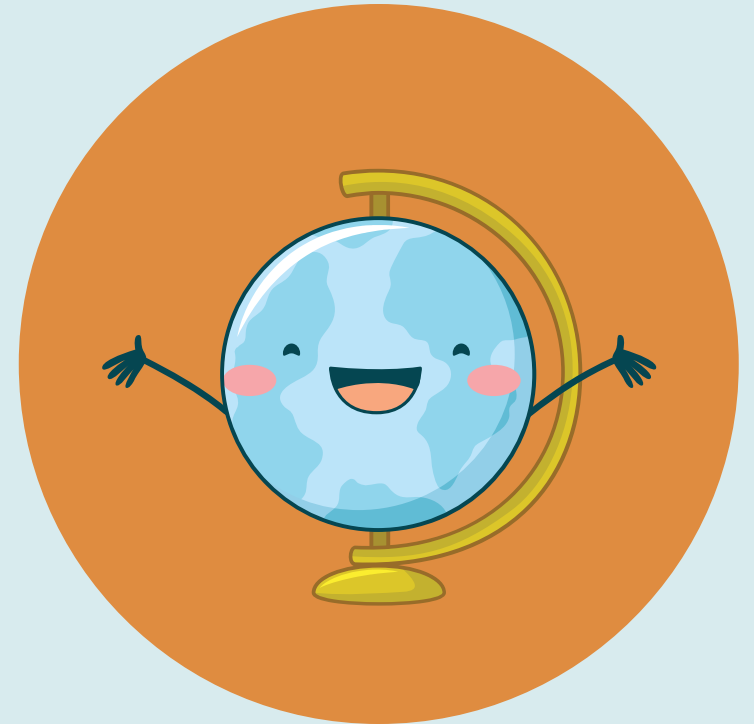
This year the Florida Department of Education expects all students to take the Florida Statewide Assessments. This includes the following assessments: FSA English Language Arts Writing and Reading; FSA Mathematics; Statewide Science Assessments; the End-of-Course assessments in Algebra 1, Geometry, Biology 1, Civics, U.S. History, and the Florida Standards Alternate Assessments (FSAA).

The results from these assessments are important and are used to make sure that your child is placed in appropriate classes and receives appropriate instruction and services.

**As such, all students physically attending school or participating in My School Online will be expected to take these assessments in person at their schools.** Your student's school is taking all necessary precautions to provide a safe environment for this testing, and you will be notified of the scheduled time(s) when your student is expected to test. We encourage all students to participate in these important measures of their academic achievement.

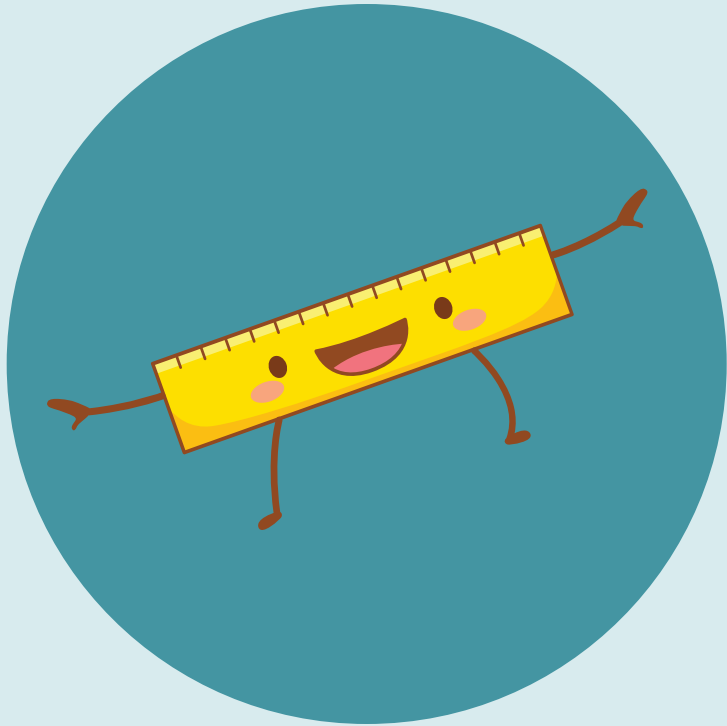
# Parent Expectations

- If your child has been selected to participate in tutoring or interventions, it is important that they attend those sessions whether they are zoom or in person.



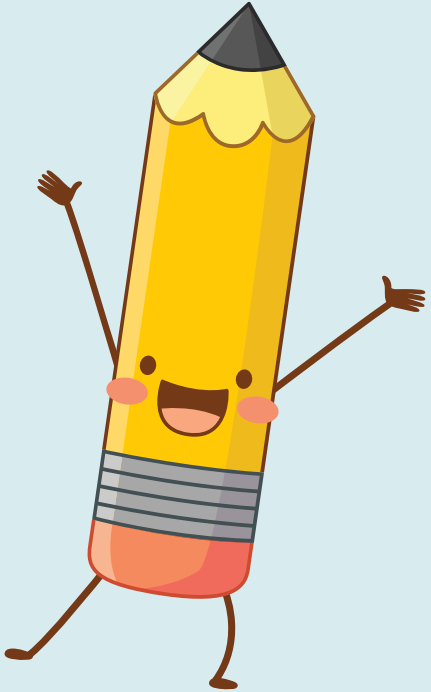
# Testing Day Expectations

Parents the following guidelines will take place in order to have a safe and smooth testing environment:



1. Classrooms will be properly sanitized daily after every testing day
2. Students will use the same classroom and same desks on all of their assigned test dates
3. Students will be required to always wear facial coverings during and after testing
4. Students will remain in school for the complete school day  
K-2<sup>nd</sup> (8:30-2:05)  
3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> (8:30 -3:05)
5. Please be on the look out for drop off and pick up instructions on the required testing days

# Testing Day Expectations Continued...



6. Students are to come to school in uniform on all required testing days
7. Staff will be available to escort the students to their assigned classrooms
8. We will be adhering to CDC guidelines for desk spacing (6ft apart)
9. Students will receive Breakfast and Lunch delivered to their classrooms on testing days.
10. MSO Students will be separated from F2F Students
11. MSO and F2f can possibly be tested by another Test Proctor in order to abide by CDC guidelines to maintain small class sizes

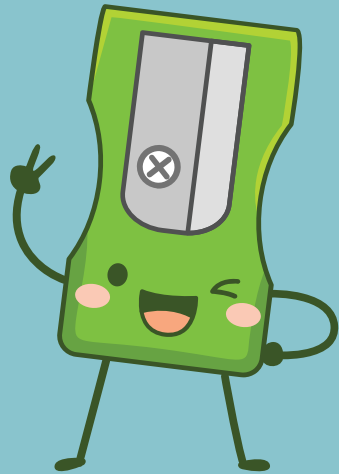

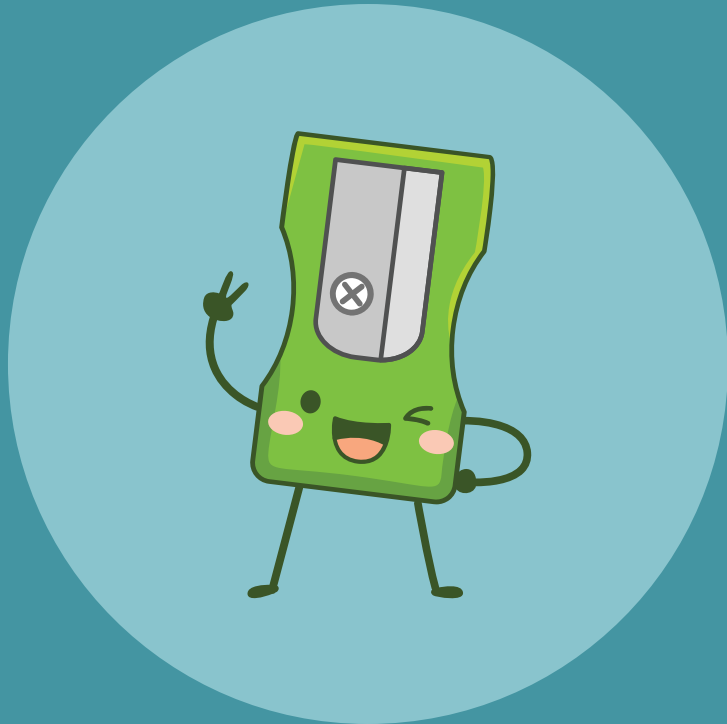

# 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade FSA UPDATES

- As of right now we have no information regarding state retentions on students that do not score a Level 2 or above on the FSA 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Reading FSA Assessment
- As soon as more information is released parents will be notified
- Retention can still take place for **ANY** student who does not meet academic requirements in Reading / Math subject areas
- Parents who are in need of information regarding retention should speak to their child's homeroom teacher as soon as possible
- Retention letters have already been sent home for students who might be in need of retention

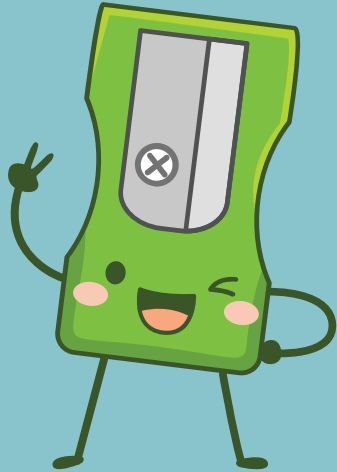
